**BRIGHT SPOT** is unrivaled as a fast, easy-to-use cleaner for removing dust, dirt or other light soil from hard surfaces. Use **BRIGHT SPOT** to clean a variety of surfaces, including table-tops, counter-tops, painted, varnished or enameled surfaces, porcelain, formica, glass, chrome and stainless steel.

**DIRECTIONS:** Shake well before using. Spray evenly over surface, taking care not to apply more than is necessary. Allow approximately 10 seconds for penetration, depending on surface and amount of soil. Wipe with a clean soft cloth or similar material. Remember to keep changing to a clean wiping surface. Frequent cleaning prevents heavy build-up.

**CAUTION:** The contents of this container are under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not store in direct sunlight or where temperature exceeds 120°F. Use ventilation adequate to maintain TLV. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. If skin is contacted rinse with plenty of water. Intentional misuse by deliberately concentrating and inhaling the contents can be harmful or fatal. Point tip away from body and eyes before spraying.
